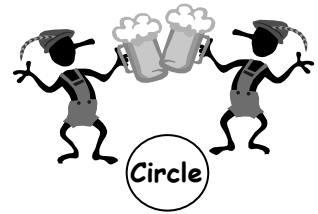

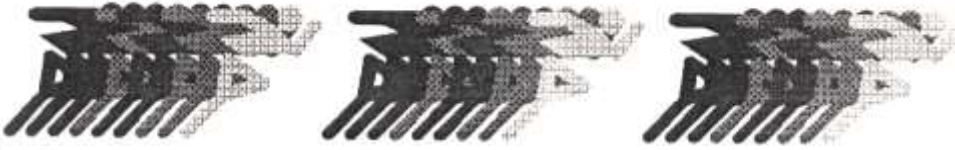

Tales from the Trail

Hash Re-Run No. 1517

(The Girls Just Wanna Have Fun Run)

Hares: **Jess Lee, Hannah Zitner**

Rabbit: **Anna Brown**

Venue: close to jetty, Myo Pat St., Seik Gyii Kha Naung To Township

Runners: 50

Weather: Bone dry and hot.

Time/Distance: 1 h 25 min to cover 10.2 km of mostly concrete roads with two Beer Stops

The three Hares decided that this was going to be a case of "If it ain't broke, don't fix it." So anyone who had been in the 'Goon for more than a few months may have had cause for a few *déjà vu* moments because this run turned out to be almost a ReHash of Run 1486, which was held on 13 Aug 2016 when the same girls (with some help from **Sex Gone Too Far**) laid a trail in the same vicinity.

Since the venue was a small, elongated island in the middle of the Twantay Canal with a longest dimension of 4.6 km from one tip to the other, the "same vicinity" didn't allow for much variation. However the girls were aware that their previous attempt at setting trail, even with the assistance of **Sex Gone Too Far**, was somewhat one-dimensional and so this time they were going to apply the lessons learned and come up with something a little different. Well that was the plan. However, the secret to developing good plans is to have good intelligence and that generally means putting in time to make reconnaissance trips. It is a moot point whether or not the girls' planning had involved any reconnaissance when they mounted their bicycles on Saturday morning at 8:30 am to go and lay shreddie but it appeared not.

To be fair, the island is shaped rather like an irregularly drawn letter "B" laid on its side and, with a maximum width of less than 1.4 km, running territory is not exactly in plentiful supply. Even so, it did appear as though the Hares had an aversion to anything that was not paved in concrete, which could well be explained by their mode of transport whilst laying paper.

For some, the shenanigans started at the Meeting Point where a dearth of Hash transport resulted in the Beer Truck being overloaded with passengers, several of whom alleviated the suffering of the journey by repeatedly sampling the contents of the cool boxes. Upon arrival at the Wardan Jetty, the well-oiled Hash logistical apparatus swung into action and sampans were procured, cool boxes were decanted from the truck to said sampans and

they, together with the Hashers, were then transported on a pleasant voyage to the distant island whilst being dive-bombed by hundreds of seagulls.

On the far side, everything was unloaded and the Hashers assembled not far from the jetty, at the junction of the road that runs through the centre of the island and the one that skirts the southern shore, Myo Pat St. Breaking from the tradition set on the previous run, instead of commencing the run with a view of the canal by running along Myo Pat St., the Harriettes pointed the Hash along the middle road, along which the Hashers had returned at the end of the previous run. So guess which road featured on the In Trail for this run? Maybe we should not get ahead of ourselves but what was last became first and what was first was obviously destined to be last.

Iron Maiden, who appeared to have had a bit of a late night, set the early pace together with the *GM*. After 500-m of running along a dead straight concrete road, crowded with humanity, they followed paper around a right hand turn. After following a slightly smaller concrete road for another 400-m or so, the pack found its first Check located at the beginning of two ponds that straddled the road. The *GM* was hoping that this was not going to set the scene for the remainder of the run - a kilometre between Checks connected by long straight concrete roads, i.e. a Hash laid by bicycle! Time would tell.

The **FRBs**, like **Johannes**, **On All Floors** and **Premature Ejaculation**, seemed to favour Checking to the left or right but the *GM* decided to press ahead. He thought he heard an *On Back* call and so did as he was told but then saw the pack being directed in his direction by **Hannah**. So it was time to return to Plan A - keep running in a straight line.

250-m later he came to a T-junction and here could not work out which way to go. Sadly he opted to go left when others found paper to his right. The trail then looped back on itself and seemed to be heading straight back to the road along which the pack had run along at the start. However, there was a Check shortly before this point and it was **Iron Maiden** who successfully worked out that the pack had to turn right and skirt a pond before completing the loop and returning to the point where he had left the Out Trail about 11 or 12-min previously.

Luckily **Iron Maiden** has a reasonable sense of geography and he was not too phased by having to reverse run part of the trail. If the truth be known, not many in the pack were phased by this development - mainly on account of the fact that they had not realised that they were running on the same paper as before but in reverse. Once back at the main road, **Iron Maiden** turned right and the straight line running commenced once more.

About 500-m later, something remarkable happened - the **FRBs** stopped running in a straight line and turned right. However, it seems that the Hares were toying with the pack because after performing a perfunctory wee loop, the pack found itself back on the main road and running in a straight line again. 150-m later there was another right turn and this took the **FRBs** like **On All Floors** a short distance to a Check located near a wooden bridge that spanned a small creek. The Check held up the **FRBs** long enough for the *GM* to catch up because they seemed to favour looking for paper straight ahead, off road and alongside the little creek. This seemed an odd choice from the *GM's* point of view unless they
